INTRODUCTION

In response to a request from a community member regarding Incidents at Gambling Facilities in Houston, **The Glenda Gordy Research Center** conducted an analysis to identify incidents at Gambling Facilities in Harris County.

This report presents an analysis of incidents at gambling facilities in Harris County with data that was compiled on August 22, 2025. We utilized data from the FBI National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) database to report on incidents that occurred in Harris County at Gambling Facilities/Casinos/Race Tracks in 2021-2023. The total number of incidents that were attempted or completed that fit our reporting criteria is **163,542**.

The following graphs show all incidents that fit these criteria, split between violent and non-violent offenses.

FIGURE 1- VIOLENT OFFENSES

The above graph shows a break-down of violent incidents at gambling facilities in Harris County in 2021-2023. The total of all violent incidents during this time is **17,665**.

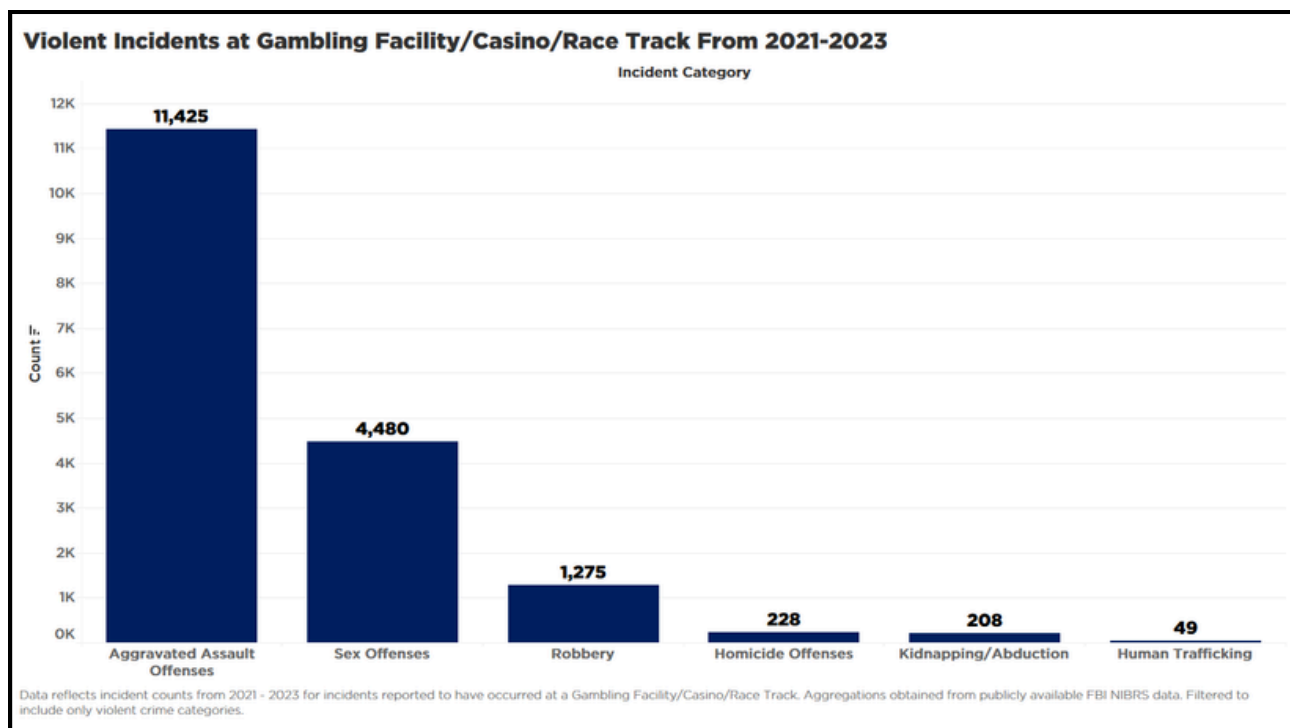
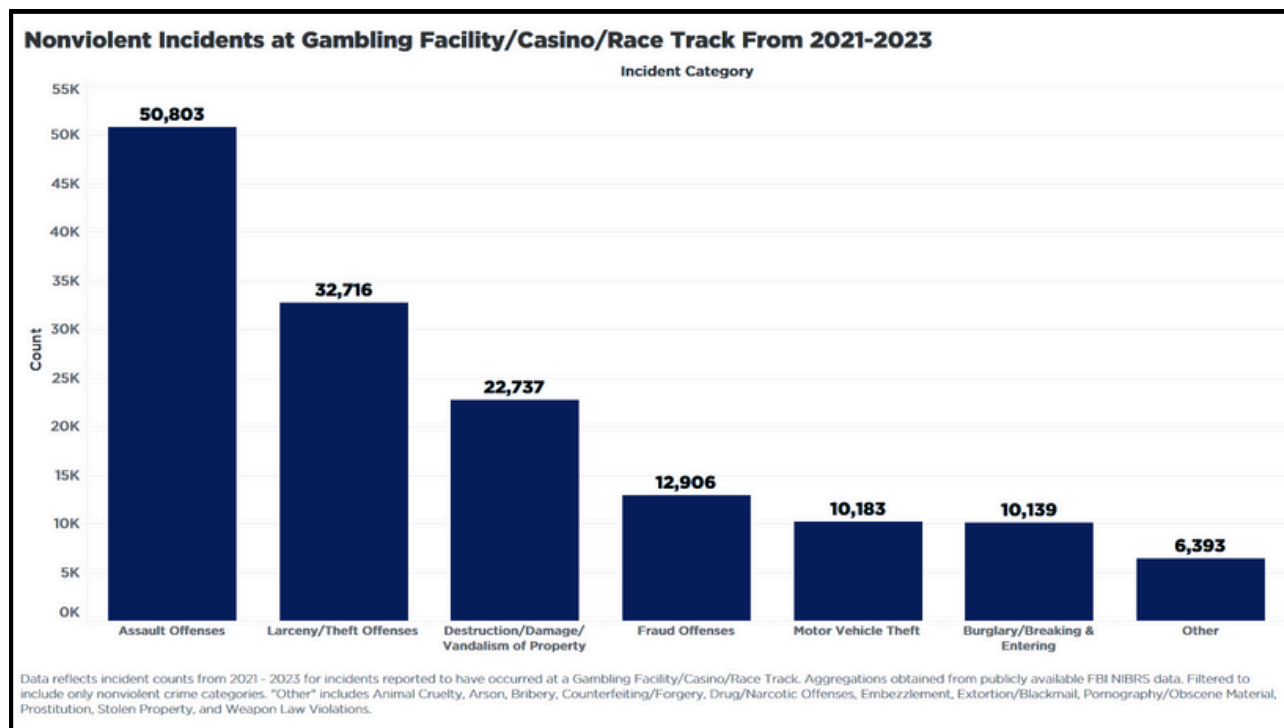


FIGURE 2 - NONVIOLENT OFFENSES

The above graph shows a break-down of non-violent incidents at gambling facilities in Harris County in 2021-2023. The total of all non-violent incidents during this time is **145,877**.
