

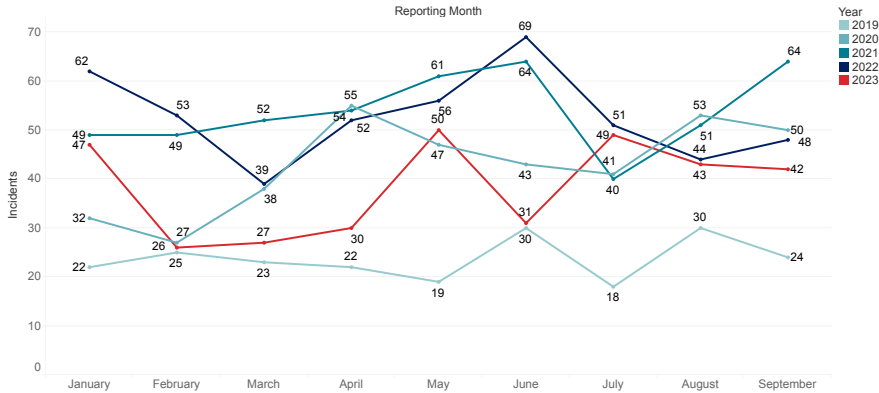
MONTHLY CRIME INDEX

SEPTEMBER 2023

In our **Monthly Crime Index**, we aim to provide you with an accurate representation of crime statistics in Harris County, Houston. The monthly statistics are represented in two graphs. The top graph reflects offenses occurrences retrieved from the Texas Department of Public Safety (TXDPS) Offense Distribution Report and reflects offense occurrences as reported by Harris County Sheriff's Office (HCSO), Houston Police Department (HPD), Pasadena Police Department (PPD) and Baytown Police Department (BPD). The bottom graph presents data retrieved from Harris County District Clerk's office (HCDC) and represents criminal cases filed in Harris County. Represented here are the figures from the month of January until month of September over the past five years for the categories of **Homicide, Aggravated Assault, Sexual Assault, and Weapons Violations.**

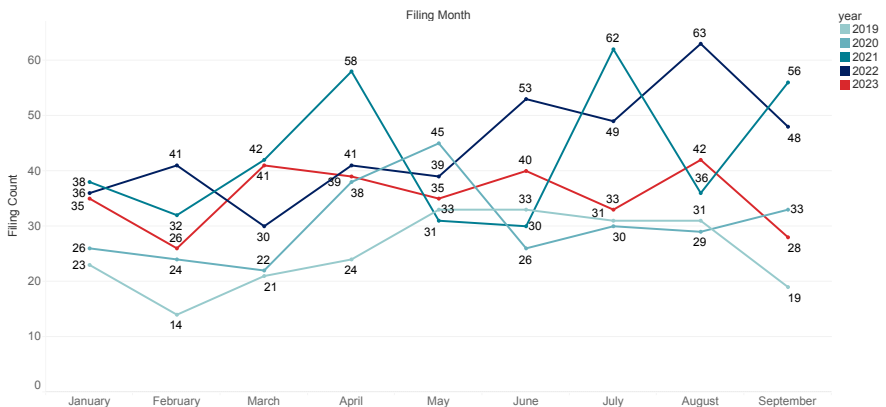
HOMICIDE:

Homicide - TXDPS



Shows the number of homicide offenses that occurred from 2019 to 2023. Data was retrieved from Texas DPS NIBRS Offense Distribution for Crime Against Person (Offense Attempted/Completed). Data was filtered for Pasadena PD, Baytown PD, HarrisCounty SO and Houston PD reports.

Homicide - HCDC



Shows the number of Homicide cases filed from 2019 to 2023 reported by Harris County District Clerk. Updated November 30, 2023.

OFFENSE OCCURRENCES

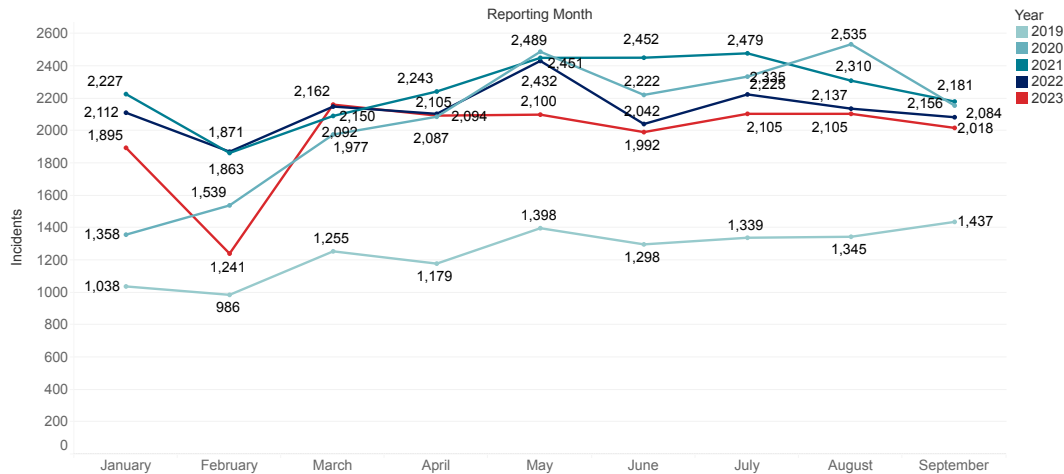
This is a line chart graph that depicts the count of Homicide offenses reported in Harris County by law enforcement from 2019 to 2023. The horizontal axis of the chart represents time in months, and the vertical axis represents the count of offenses reported during that period. The data indicates that there have been high fluctuations in the number of reported incidents over the years. The lowest number was recorded in July of 2019 at 18 and highest number was recorded at 69 in June of 2022. We have seen a **27.22% decrease** in Homicide offenses reported from January 1 to September 30th, 2023, compared to the same reporting period last year. There has been a total of 345 homicide offenses reported by Harris County Law Enforcement during this reporting period in 2023, and 474 Homicide Offenses reported during the reporting period in 2022.

CASES FILED

This is a line chart graph that depicts the count of Homicide cases filed in Harris County from 2019 to 2023. The horizontal axis of the chart represents time in months, and the vertical axis represents the count of cases filed during the months of January-September for each of the past 5 years. The data shows significant fluctuations in the number of cases filed in Harris County since 2019. The highest number of Homicide criminal cases filed was recorded at 63 in August of 2022 and the lowest number was recorded at 14 in February of 2019. We have seen a **20.25% decrease** in Homicide cases filed from January 1-September 30th, 2023, compared to the same reporting period last year. There has been a total of 319 Homicide criminal cases filed during this reporting period in 2023, and 400 Homicide criminal cases filed during the reporting period in 2022.

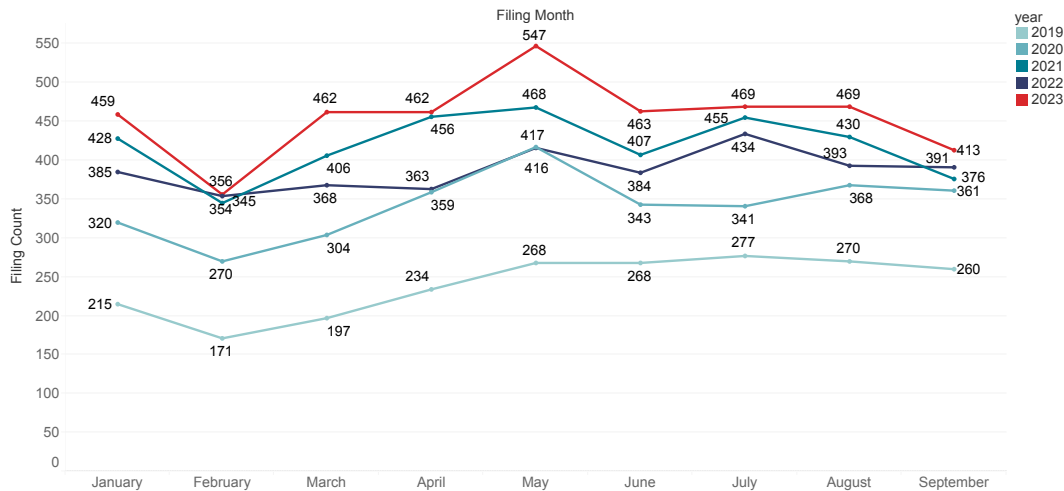
AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

OFFENSE OCCURENCES

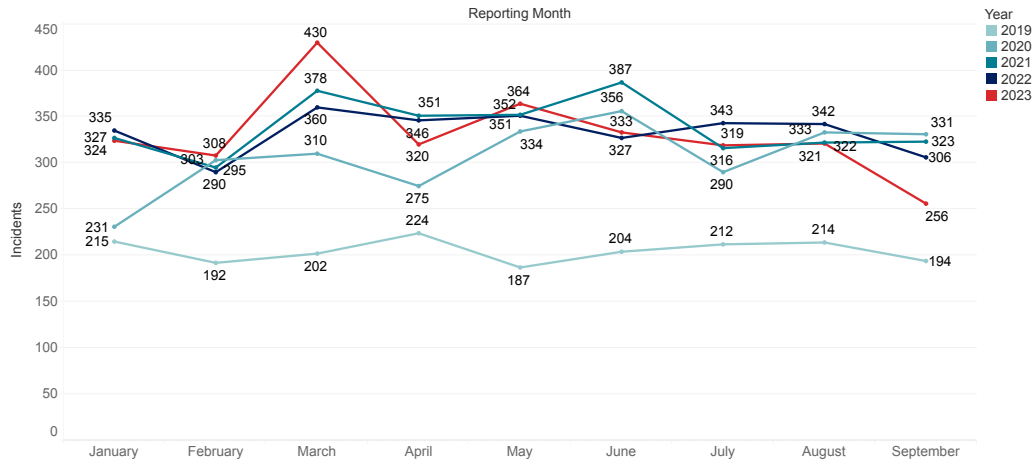
This is a line chart graph that depicts the count of Aggravated Assault offenses reported in Harris County by law enforcement from 2019 to 2023. The horizontal axis of the chart represents time in months, and the vertical axis represents the count of offenses reported during that period. The data indicates that there have been high fluctuations in the number of reported incidents over the years. The lowest number was recorded in February of 2019 at 986 and highest number was recorded at 2535 in August of 2020. We have seen a **7.55% decrease** in Aggravated Assault offenses reported from January 1-September 30th, 2023, compared to the same reporting period last year. There has been a total of 17,712 Aggravated Assault offenses reported by Harris County Law Enforcement during this reporting period in 2023, and 19,158 Aggravated Assault Offenses reported during the reporting period in 2022.

CASES FILED

This is a line chart graph that depicts the count of Aggravated Assault cases filed in Harris County from 2019 to 2023. The horizontal axis of the chart represents time in months, and the vertical axis represents the count of cases filed during the months of January-September for each of the past 5 years. The data shows significant fluctuations in the number of cases filed in Harris County since 2019. The highest number of Aggravated Assault criminal cases filed was recorded at 547 in May of 2023 and the lowest number was recorded at 171 in February of 2019. We have seen a **17.56% increase** in Aggravated Assault cases filed from January 1-September 30th, 2023, compared to the same reporting period last year. There has been a total of 4100 Aggravated Assault criminal cases filed during this reporting period in 2023, and 3488 Aggravated Assault cases criminal cases filed during the reporting period in 2022.

SEXUAL ASSAULT

Sexual Assault - TXDPS

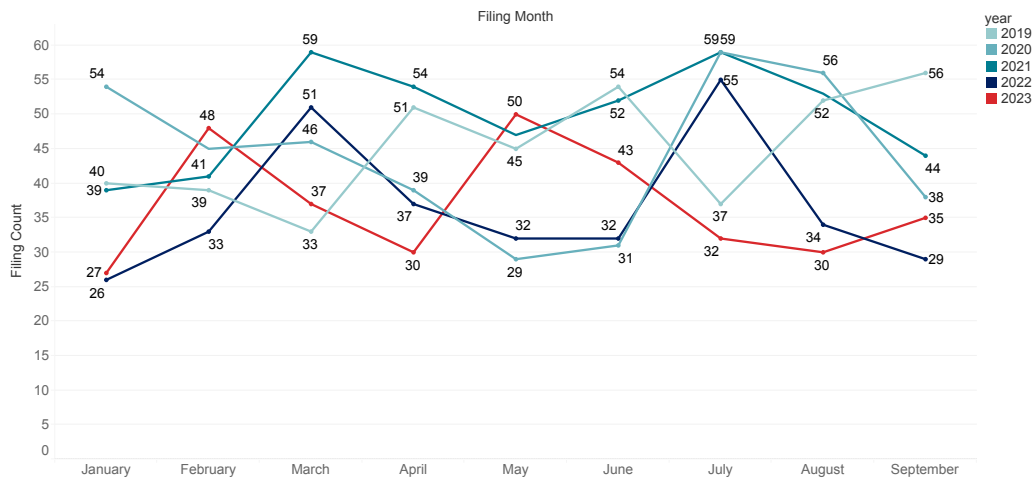


Shows the number of sexual assault offenses that occurred from 2019 to 2023. Data was retrieved from Texas DPS NIBRS Offense Distribution for Crime Against Person (Offense Attempted/Completed). Data was filtered for Pasadena PD, Baytown PD, Harris County SO and Houston PD reports.

OFFENSE OCCURENCES

This is a line chart graph that depicts the count of Sexual Assault offenses reported in Harris County by law enforcement from 2019 to 2023. The horizontal axis of the chart represents time in months, and the vertical axis represents the count of offenses reported during that period. The data indicates that there have been high fluctuations in the number of reported incidents over the years. The lowest number was recorded in May of 2019 at 187 and highest number was recorded at 430 in March of 2023. We have seen a **0.83% decrease** in Sexual Assault offenses reported from January 1-September 30th, 2023, compared to the same reporting period last year. There has been a total of 2975 Sexual Assault Offenses reported by Harris County Law Enforcement during this reporting period in 2023, and 3000 Sexual Assault Offenses reported during the reporting period in 2022.

Sexual Assault - HCDC



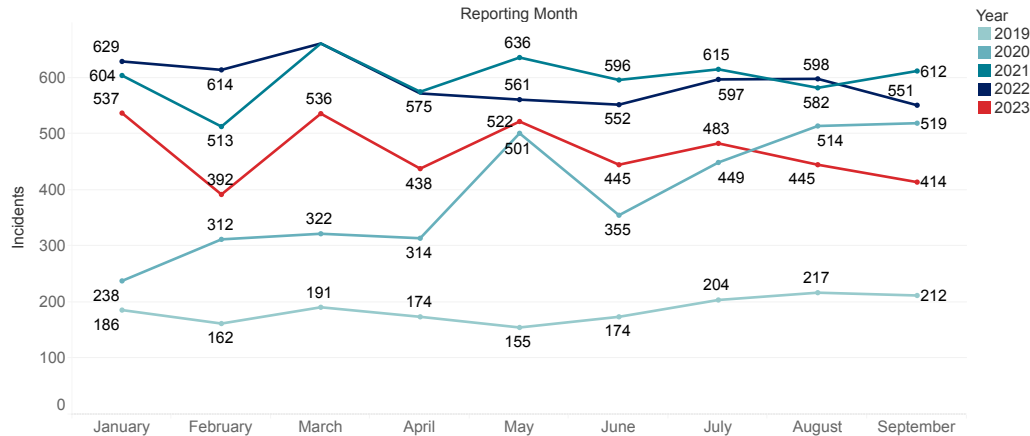
Shows the number of Sexual Assault cases filed from 2019 to 2023 reported by Harris County District Clerk. Updated November 30, 2023.

CASES FILED

This is a line chart graph that depicts the count of Sexual Assault cases filed in Harris County from 2019 to 2023. The horizontal axis of the chart represents time in months, and the vertical axis represents the count of cases filed during the months of January-September for each of the past 5 years. The data shows significant fluctuations in the number of cases filed in Harris County since 2019. The highest number of Sexual Assault criminal cases filed was recorded at 59 in March and July of 2021 and July of 2020, the lowest number was recorded at 26 in January of 2022. We have seen a **0.606% increase** in Sexual Assault cases filed from January 1-September 30th, 2023, compared to the same reporting period last year. There has been a total of 332 Sexual Assault criminal cases filed during this reporting period in 2023, and 330 Sexual Assault criminal cases filed during the reporting period in 2022.

WEAPON VIOLATIONS

Weapon Violations - TXDPS

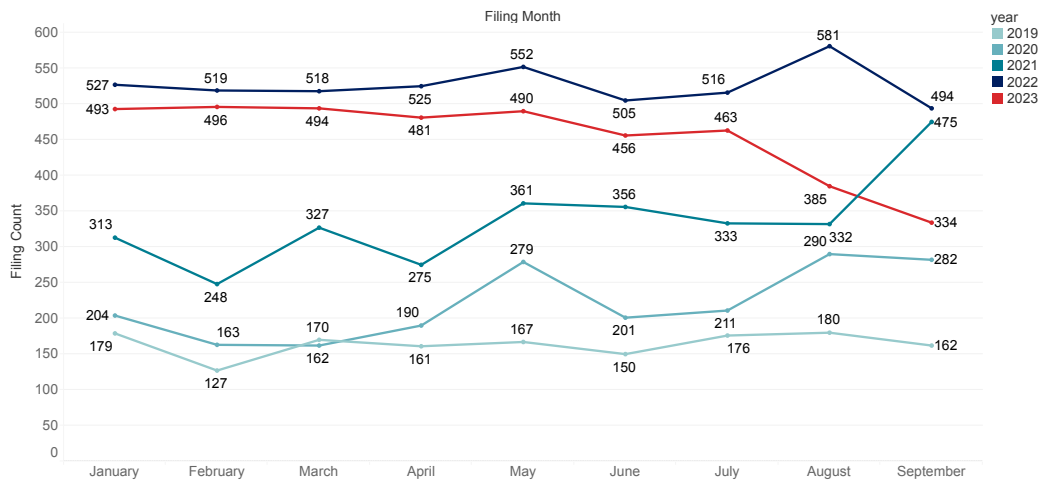


Shows the number of weapon violation offenses that occurred from 2019 to 2023. Data was retrieved from Texas DPS NIBRS Offense Distribution for Crime Against Person (Offense Attempted/Completed). Data was filtered for Pasadena PD, Baytown PD, HarrisCounty SO and Houston PD reports.

OFFENSE OCCURENCES

This is a line chart graph that depicts the count of Weapon Violations offenses reported in Harris County by law enforcement from 2019 to 2023. The horizontal axis of the chart represents time in months, and the vertical axis represents the count of offenses reported during that period. The data indicates that there have been high fluctuations in the number of reported incidents over the years. The lowest number was recorded in May of 2019 at 155 and highest number was recorded at 661 in March of 2021 and 2022. We have seen a **21.03% decrease** in Weapon Violations offenses reported from January 1-September 30th, 2023, compared to the same reporting period last year. There has been a total of 4212 Weapon Violations offenses reported by Harris County Law Enforcement during this reporting period in 2023, and 5335 Weapon Violations Offenses reported during the reporting period in 2022.

Weapon Violations - HCDC

CASES FILED

This is a line chart graph that depicts the count of Weapon Violations cases filed in Harris County from 2019 to 2023. The horizontal axis of the chart represents time in months, and the vertical axis represents the count of cases filed during the months of January-September for each of the past 5 years. The data shows significant fluctuations in the number of cases filed in Harris County since 2019. The highest number of Weapon Violations criminal cases filed was recorded at 581 in August of 2022 and the lowest number was recorded at 127 in February of 2019. We have seen a **13.62% decrease** in Weapon Violations cases filed from January 1-September 30th, 2023, compared to the same reporting period last year. There has been a total of 4092 Weapon Violations criminal cases filed during this reporting period in 2023, and 4737 Weapon Violations criminal cases filed during the reporting period in 2022.
